Thanks to the German Embassy in Ottawa and Dr Lysack's Speaker Tours almost 20 interesting meetings, talks and discussions happened in four days in Ottawa (climate talk), Victoria and Vancouver (Renewable Cities). Canada already has a high share of renewables (hydro) in their energy systems and a coal phase out plan by 2030- similar to German discussions arises around a sustainable transportation and buildings transformation as well as a phase out of oil and gas. In Canada, very dirty energy exploitation (oil sands and fracking) hinder a full decarbonisation and a reduction of emissions. The visit to <u>T'Soukes Nation</u> in Victoria impressively has shown that not only the wonderful landscape is in danger with more fossil fuel drilling (pipelines and tanker ships harm the environment) but especially that a <u>decentralized</u>, <u>participatory and democratic</u> "Energiewende" has evolved by most affected and sensible people. Indigenous people in Canada have a 10.000 years of history show an impressive power to climate protection in different ways. Very inspiring and remarkable meeting has been a meeting with **David Suzuki** and his team of the foundation.
